Dear Representative Brady:

On behalf of the more than 2 million retirees and future retirees represented by the National Retiree Legislative Network (NRLN), I am requesting that you support calling for a vote in the Committee on Ways and Means on **H.R. 3415, Real-Time Beneficiary Drug Cost.**

Passage of this bill would help seniors pay less for their prescriptions by providing patients and doctors with real-time information about how much a prescription will cost a patient, at various pharmacies while still in the doctor's office. This information enables doctors to prescribe a cheaper prescription drug, when appropriate, and enables patients to be informed in deciding where to fill their prescription.

H.R. 3415 would require Medicare Part D prescription plan providers to upload prescription plan information into a real-time benefit tool that utilizes electronic health records to inform health care providers about coverage and benefit information.
